Archibald Ward Gardner studied medicine at Glasgow University, qualifying in 1945. He spent some time in the Navy and then went to London to study for postgraduate qualifications in preventative medicine and occupational health. Most of his working life was spent in the oil, petrochemical and shipping industries. Dr Gardner wrote books on occupational health, first aid and preventative medicine and many of his arrangements of music were published.
