Fleming of Wigtown (additional) and other charters

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For the rest of the Fleming of Wigtown charters, see Ch.15531-16730. The basis for the first part of this listing (where applicable) is F J Grant (ed) *Charter Chest of the Earldom of Wigtown, 1214-1681*, Scottish Record Society, 1910, (hereafter CCEW). An annotated copy of this may be found at MS.20771. There are two other significant groupings of non-Fleming material in this accession. The first consists of 16th-17th century charters of the Earls Marischal and the second of 19th century deeds relating to property in Sierra Leone.

1. CCEW 174 Patent, 19 March 1606, of James VI to John Lord Fleming creating him Earl of Wigtown, (seal).
2. CCEW 455 Protestation, 17 January 1513, of John Lord Fleming against the sheriff-depute of Lanark not to proceed in the service of Robert Tinto of Crimpcramp in the lands of Muirhouse.
3. CCEW 547 Charter, 15 January 1557, of James Lord Fleming to his brother John of lands of Kilbocko, (seal).
4. CCEW 576 Gift, 26 March 1584, by King James VI under privy seal to John Lord Fleming of non-entry duties of Kilbocko, (seal).
5. CCEW 581 Tack, 29 May 1580, James VI to John Lord Fleming of the lands of Henderland, (seal).
6. CCEW 839 Obligation, 3 February 1557, of James Lord Fleming (in respect of his going to France) to infest John Fleming his brother in the lands of Drips, Cambusdrennie, Westwood, Bad, Quarter Chappell, Glenquotho, and £50 out of the lands of Kers, (seal).
7. CCEW 863 bundle of writs, 1593-1656 relating to the lands of Carwood (some with seals).
8. CCEW ex 864 tack, 1619, of John Earl of Wigtown to Malcolm Fleming of Cardone of the lands of Smalhoppes in Glenquhom (seal).
9. CCWE ex 868 Sasine, 1567, of Mary Queen of Scots to John Lord Fleming of the lands of Cardross.
10. CCEW ex 879 disposition, 1665, to Mr John Brown of the lands of Mosside of Biggar, dispositions, 1659 to Mr Alexander Bertram of the lands of Lindsay.

11. Royal letters, 1611, for theft against Arthur Jardine in Sibbilbesyde.
12. Burgess tickets, 1614-1726, to various Earls of Wigtown. Burghs include Glasgow, Linlithgow, Cupar, Perth, Ayr, New Galloway, Whithorn and a commission for the Royal Company of Archers, (seals).
13. Bond, 1633, of John Johnstone of that ilk to the Earl of Wigtown concerning the maintenance of Lady Jean Fleming.
14. Clare constat, 1667, of John Earl of Wigtown to James Hope of Hopetoun of lands in Biggar.
15. Writs, 1670-8, of and to the Earls of Wigtown and their family including royal charter 1670 and sasine, 1674 to George Lockhart advocate.
16. Writs, 1700-35, of and to John Earl of Wigtown including his commission as chamberlain of Fife, 1735 and a number of documents concerning Alexander Bertram of Nisbitt.
17. Writs relating to property in Falkirk, 1716-1773, owners included Archibald Campbell, John Kincaid and William Young.
18. Writs 1733-47, given to the signet clerk to draw up a discharge of John Earl of Wigtown's heritable bond to George Earl of Morton.

19. Sasines, charters and instruments of resignation, 1592-3, of and to William, Lord Keith relating to the Lordship of Inverugy.
20. Sasines charters and instruments of resignation, 1612, of and to William, Lord Keith relating to the Lordships of Inverugy and Altyre.
21. Sasines charters and instruments of resignation, 1633-1693 of and to the Earls Marischal.

22. Act of parliament, 1745, to enable Daniel Carmichael of Mauldsley to sell lands in Lanark and Fife.
