- 12-13. Scrapbooks with clippings from North American newspapers, 1914-18. Relating mostly to H.L.'s campaigning and charity work in support of the Allied Forces in the Great War.
14. Box of photographs in 3 sections; plus outsized and miscellaneous from throughout his life:
 - A. *Performing*: stage work, publicity shots and studio portraits in character.
 - B. *On the Road*: publicity/charity work; including a photograph of a meeting with Winston Churchill; 2 photos plus copies of H.L. speaking to soldiers near the Front during the Great War, 4 photos of H.L. meeting with "Musaire" described as "Europe's only Thereminist". Dublin 1935. Photograph of H.L. during World War II, publicly thanking the crews of American food ships who had delivered much-needed supplies to Britain in her hour of need, c.1944.
 - C. *Personal*: Including a mounted photograph of the day shift at Hamilton mine c.1892 with H.L. in the middle of the back row.
3 photos of John Lauder, H.L.'s only son, who was killed in action in the Great War, 1916.
2 studio portraits of Alick Lauder, H.L.'s brother, himself an entertainer; Photos of the numerous visitors to Lauder Ha'; including : Danny Kaye, Will Fyffe and Indian Yogi Paramahansa Yogananda.
