 - (i) Registration book, 1943-8; includes sight test and 2nd World War gunnery certificates.
 - (ii) Registration book, 1948-69: voyages covered are mostly with the Clan Line, Glasgow.
 - (iii) Certificate of Competency of Captain Wallace as Master of a foreign-going steamship, dated 16 Jan. 1953.
 - (iv) Membership book of the Navigators and Engineer Officers Union, 1948-55.
