COLLECTION OF SOCIALIST PAMPHLET LITERATURE, AND PRESS CUTTINGS ON UK INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COLLECTED AND ARRANGED BY IAN S WOOD AND USED IN HIS RESEARCH, 1902-1989

Ian S Wood was a lecturer at Napier University, Edinburgh, and a tutor with the Open University. He is a member of the Scottish Labour History Society and served as editor of the Society's Journal from 1974–1989. He has written and edited several books including a biography of John Wheatley and an exploration of the relationship between Scotland and Ireland: Scotland and Ulster.

This collection has been arranged largely according to Ian Wood's own classification. The majority of the collection is made up of socialist pamphlet literature and this has been split into four series: American Socialist Literature 1902-1955; British Socialist Literature 1919-1966; Socialist literature from other parts of the world 1963-1986; and Socialist literature by or regarding Guy Aldred, Glasgow Anarchist 1937-1967. The material by Guy Aldred has been kept apart from the other pamphlets to reflect Ian Wood's arrangement and because it represents a significant body of work by one individual.

The remainder of this collection comprises two further series. The first series represents papers regarding the group Scottish Labour Action, 1988-1990, a Scottish body within the Labour Party. The papers largely consist of printed material based around the themes of the Poll Tax and the Scottish Constitutional Convention. The final series is a large amount of press cuttings with notes by Ian Wood, 1978-1989, concerning UK industrial relations in the motor industry and events surrounding the miners' strike of 1984.
