## Craigmount School, 1936-66

Craigmount was founded in Edinburgh in 1874 as a school for boys, but ten years later it was re-opened as a boarding school for girls. From 1939-52, the school was at Scone Palace, Perthshire, and at the end of the summer term, 1952, it moved to Minto. The school closed in 1966.
