Dr. Heinrich Schliemann's (1822-1890) 1876 excavations at Mycenae and Tiryns in Greece were extensively recorded with photographs and plans. The photographers were known as the Rhomaides Brothers (Konstantinos Rhomaides d.1900 and Aristotelis Rhomaides d.1916) who specialised in archaeological photography were the principal photographers.

Originally collected in three albums, containing prints of the site and the almost 700 items excavated at Mycenae, there are also sixteen colour drawings, one oil painting and six plans by the engineer Vasilios Drosinos and artist D. Tounopoulos. These photographs, plans and drawings were used in Schliemann's book *Mycenae and Tiryns* (1878: John Murray, London).
