33. 45 autograph MS 8vo leaves in Rosebery's hand in ink in an envelope titled "Rectorial Rubbish".
34. 2 copies of a 9-page 4to typescript titled "A Romance in the House of Rosebery".
35. 3-page typescript funeral address for Thomas Robartes dated in Rosebery's hand Oct 11 1915; with 1½pp MS appreciation in Rosebery's hand.
36. 7-page 4to MS in Rosebery's hand titled "A Day at Battle", commencing with the words "Yesterday my sister Constance & I went down to see our old home...", dated July 1 1916.
37. 1½-page 4to MS in Rosebery's hand, commencing "I am anxious to send on behalf of Great Britain a message of sympathy and admiration to our gallant troops at the front...".
38. 9-page typescript entitled 'A Great Scotsman' by Sybil Grant on Rosebery (her father).
39. 139-page 4to typescript of Rosebery's North American Journal, 1873.
40. Letter of G F Watts, 2pp 8vo, to Rosebery, 11 March 1892. (Watts painted a number of portraits of Rosebery's family).
41. Letter of G A Sala to Rosebery regarding the text of a poem (transcribed on verso) and accepting an invitation to Mentmore. Whit Monday 1880.
42. ca.20 leaves containing notes on Napoleon III, Henry Labouchere, John C Hobhouse, (Lord Broughton) and Lord Randolph Churchill.
43. Small notebook containing miscellaneous notes.
44. Envelope containing ca.25 Derby Owner Badges and some Durdans book-plates.
