John Ritchie Richmond was born in 1869. He was educated at Glasgow High School and then studied at Glasgow University, with the intention of pursuing a literary career, but he left without graduating to join the engineering firm of his step-father, G & J Weir. Richmond edited and prefaced a volume *Poetical Works of Thomas Chatterton*, Lond., 1885 when he was only 16.

His interest in art also developed at an early age and his collection included works by Monet, Pissarro, Degas, D Y Cameron and Russel Flint . Richmond was Honarary President of Glasgow School of Art and a member of the Royal Fine Art Commission for Scotland.

He died in 1963
