8. Commissions, 1765-1864, to James Christie of Riddry, Col Sir Archibald DeBourghs Christie, Frederick Gordon Christie, Andrew DeBourghs Leslie Christie. Burgess Tickets to Alexander Foulis of Ratho, 1710, and James Christie of Riddry, 1790. Marriage certificate of Archibald Christie and Jane Dwyer, 1800, and draft Grant of Arms to Archibald Christie, 1818.

9. Miscellaneous papers, 1643-1838, n.d. Included are printed Acts of Parliament, 1645 and 1681, a copy of the Declaration of Plombieres, 29 August 1714 of James Francis Edward Stuart, Prince of Wales, 18th century, 'Elegy ... on the death of the most pious and virtuous Lady Barbara Foulis ...' 1715, and an anagram 'On the Death of the honoured Mr James Christy of Stentoun', 18th century.
