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Business correspondence and financial papers of Messrs Bell and Bradfute Booksellers and Publishers, Edinburgh 1778-1941. The bulk of the Bell and Bradfute material in this accession (excepting a few strays) covers the years 1778-1844. With a few exceptions, it falls into yearly bundles of receipts and monthly bundles of business correspondence; where these bundles have been broken up and material lost, a composite arrangement has been used for nos.44-7. Other Bell and Bradfute material may be found in Dep.193 and 317, and Acc.8500. This particular accession may be a stray from Dep.317.
