Diaries, 1906-1936, of Arthur Birnie, Lecturer in Economic History, University of Edinburgh. The diaries relate to two periods of Arthur Birnie's life: 1906-1909 when he was a pupil at George Heriot's School, Edinburgh, and later an undergraduate at Edinburgh University; and 1934-1939 at which time he was a lecturer at Edinburgh University.

The diaries are of particular interest for the insight they give into social and academic life in Edinburgh in the first half of the twentieth century.
