Minute Books, 1893-1989, of the Camanachd Association, the ruling body for shinty, and its subsidiary bodies, the North of Scotland Shinty Association and the South of Scotland Shinty Association. With some accounts, letters, reports and fixture lists.

The Camanachd Association was formed in Kingussie in 1893. Then, representatives of twenty-three northern clubs met at the invitation of the Kingussie Shinty Club to form a national association to promote the game of shinty and to formulate a single set of rules and regulations acceptable to all.
