Cameron of Fassiefern (1661-1848), letters mostly to members of the Fassiefern family - especially to John Cameron of Fassiefern and his son Sir Ewan (1st Bart) including some legal documents and business papers. There are also papers pertaining to the Cameron chiefs Sir Ewan, John and Donald of Locheil. For other papers of this family see Acc.9174, Acc.11137 and also, at the Scottish Record Office, GD1/736.
