Eileen Caddy's notebooks, in which she recorded her spiritual guidance, 1955- 1982, n.d., are of particular importance. The notebooks of Patrick Lidington, a long-term member of the Findhorn Foundation are also included.

Peter and Eileen Caddy, together with Dorothy Maclean, established the Findhorn Foundation in Nairn in the north of Scotland in the early 1960s. For records of the Findhorn Foundation see Accs.9934, 10381 and 10560.
