Literary papers, 1971-2003, of Alison Fell (b. 1944), poet and novelist. Alison Fell was born in Dumfries, and lived in various parts of Scotland before moving to London in 1970, where she worked in the Women's Street Theatre Group and for *Spare Rib*.

Her first collection of poems, *Kisses for Mayakovsky*, won the Alice Hunt Bartlett Award in 1984, and her novel, *Mer de Glace*, won the Boardman Tasker Award in 1991.
