1. "The Appearance of Ripoll at Valencia; his primary teaching". In the hand of Mrs Borrow. 15pp. Paper watermarked 1840.
2. Holograph manuscript of the poem "The Count of Vendel's Daughter", stanzas 1 to 5, and stanzas 18 (last two lines) to 26 on two sheets of paper. On the verso of sheet one are two two-line stanzas numbered 22 and 23. This poem appeared in print in *Once a Week* for 3 January 1863. The holograph of the other stanzas is in another collection (Collie and Fraser, *George Borrow, a Bibliographical Study*, p.157).
3. Two sheets of notes on mythologies and fairies, in an unknown hand.
4. A page of an unidentified manuscript, in George Borrow's hand.
5. Letter from Borrow to G. Simpson, Lowestoft, 15 March 1843.
6. Notice inviting Borrow to the funeral of Catherine C. Roper, 23 May 1835.
