- 3 Print-out of chapters 12-21 of a biography of her father by Fiona Rudd (née Calder) covering the period of the Second World War, with a family tree and a copy of an article by the same writer on Ritchie Calder's participation in, and reporting on, the Jarrow March of 1936 (published in the *New Statesman*, 7 November 1986).
