Journal, March-September 1858, of Francis Goode Cuningham (1836-1911), describing his journey from Australia to New Zealand for the purpose of starting a sheep farm. Includes two photographs and several news cuttings.

Francis Goode Cuningham was born in Ayrshire, the younger son of an Indian army officer. As a young man he emigrated to Australia and briefly to New Zealand. Eventually he returned to England where he settled first in London and then in Bentley, Hampshire.
