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Peter Hodgkiss and the Ernest Press

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Climbing journals, correspondence and working papers, 1965 – 2009, undated, of Peter Hodgkiss, mountaineer and publisher [1936 – 2010] and the Ernest Press.

Peter Hodgkiss was born in Leeds in 1936 but spent most of his life in Glasgow. He was a keen sportsman, with interests in rowing and cycling and a lifelong passion for mountaineering. In 1985, with Jack Baines (who died in 1996), Hodgkiss set up the Ernest Press specialising in mountain and mountaineering publications. The Ernest Press received much acclaim as the publisher of four winners of the Boardman Tasker Prize for mountain literature. It was also noted as the publisher of numerous guidebooks and journals for various mountaineering clubs and latterly for its Mountain Biking guidebooks.

The journals are of particular interest as a record of the climbing activities of a keen mountaineer. The correspondence files consist of Peter Hodgkiss' personal as well as business letters while book files relates to his business activities with the Ernest Press.
