These papers consist of part of the surviving correspondence of Sylvester Douglas, Baron Glenbervie, and his wife Catherine, daughter of Lord North. The correspondence is primarily family and social rather than political, but it includes many letters from members of the North family, and the family of Charles Grant, Baron Glenelg, as well as letters from the 4th Earl of Aberdeen, William Adam of Blairadam, the 1st and 2nd Barons Auckland, William Brummell, Lady Charlotte Bury, and John Jamieson. Amongst the copies of Lord Glenbervie's outgoing letters is one to Sir Joseph Banks.
