Papers of Lawrence R. Burness, consisting of Second World War correspondence and photographs, 1940-47.

Burness was working in Burma from 1936, and was commissioned into the Burma R.N.V.R. in 1940. All of his letters to his mother, father and sister were carefully retained by his father, along with copies of his father's replies. Burness then assembled this collection in the 1980s. Extracts from the typed letters have been pasted into three volumes, the first of which contains a brief background to the collection.

A set of the photographs and a microfilm copy of the volumes of correspondence was also given by the donor to the Imperial War Museum in London.
