1. Diary of visit to America, 1885-6. Graham Balfour was employed by the Russell family to accompany (and watch over) John FS, 2nd Earl Russell around America and Canada.
2. Letters, 1891-2, describing a trip from London via Italy, Egypt and Japan to Hawaii, to stay with his cousin R L Stevenson.
3. Book inscribed '1892-3' describing (i) life at Vailima, August-November 1892; (ii) trip to Fiji, Tonga, New Zealand, Tasmania and Australia, November 1892 – March 1893, returning to Samoa from Sydney; (iii) life at Vailima April-September 1893; (iv) return to London via USA. Loosely enclosed are letters of GB, printed maps of Tasmania and the inland lakes of Otago, and other items.
4. Book inscribed 'Samoa 1894' containing (i) diary of journey from London to Samoa via Australia, March-June 1894; (ii) life at Vailima, June-October 1894; (iii) commonplaces. Loosely enclosed are leaves written at New Zealand, February 1893 and Sydney, March 1893, and other items.
5. Book inscribed 'Diary October 1884 – February 1895, containing diary of voyage in SS 'Archer' to Fiji via Gilbert, Ellice and Marshall Islands to Jaluit, Manila and Hong Kong, October 1894 – February 1895. Loosely enclosed are letters of and to Graham Balfour, and other items.
6. Book inscribed 'Diary 1895-6', describing stay at Samoa, May-June 1895. Loosely enclosed are letters to GB and other items.
7. Book inscribed on first leaf 'Copies of my correspondence, August-December 1895 relating to the publication of Louis', posthumous works. No value now'.
