- How was Peter able to find a position as a clerk in Pennsylvania, and then as an assistant engineer on the Chenango Canal project?
- Read page three of the letter. Why might Mr Archibald have wanted to help Peter, an emigrant from Scotland?
- Was Peter able to use any of his existing skills in his new profession?
